• Can you verify the storage tanks for Bulk deliveries Caustic Soda 25%? Is there a temporary 1,000 gallon tank or has construction been completed for (2) 9,000 gallon tanks? Deliveries must be done in tank type trucks and unloaded by a self-contained conveyance system into the Water Treatment Plant's temporary 1,000-galion tank. If the contractor's truck requires additional types of connections, other than what is in place, the contractor must provide the required connection and remove after each delivery. After construction of the new bulk chemical storage facility is complete, deliveries will be unloaded into two (2) 9,000 gallon tanks.

Construction has been completed.
